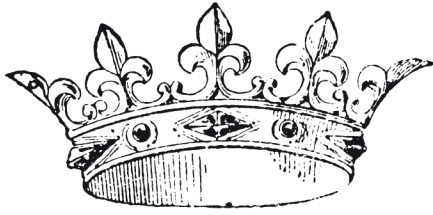

Matthew is trying to show how Jesus is the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy. Write down every time you notice Matthew referencing the Old Testament.



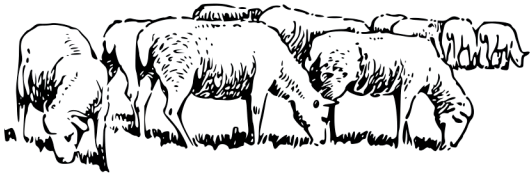

Mark was written to a primarily Roman or gentile audience. Where do you see examples of this in his gospel?



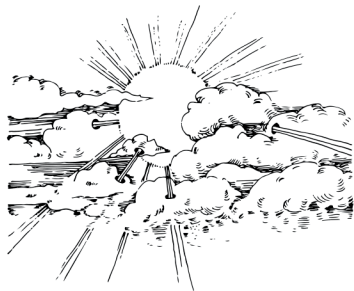
